he Human Resource Management Professionals Examinations Board (HRMPEB) has released the results for the Certified Human Resource Professional (CHRP) examinations conducted in November 2023, along with the inaugural Competency-Based Education and Training (CBET) Diploma in HR on January 22, 2023.

Out of a total of 1,366 candidates, 746 pursued the Old CHRP Curriculum, achieving an impressive average pass rate of 89.58% across all three parts. CHRM College proudly led in 17 out of 22 units in the old curriculum and 10 out of 19 units in the new curriculum.
